WHO DO YOU SAY THAT I AM?



When Jesus asked his disciples, “Who do people say that the Son of Man is”, he wasn’t just playing a game to see who would guess his identity first. Rather, he was seeking much more than this. At first the disciples answered, “Some say John the Baptist, others Elijah, still others Jeremiah or one of the prophets.”

Jesus wasn’t interested in what others were saying, that is why he responded, “But who do you say that I am?” And Peter responded, “You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.” Jesus didn’t congratulate him and tell him he won. Rather, Jesus was looking for 2 things, namely, “Do you love me and will you carry on my work?”

Jesus asks every would-be-follower the same question today, “Who do you say that I am?” In other words, “Who am I to you?” Am I the central figure of your life? Do you place other things before me? How often do you think of me during your day? Do you love others as much as I love you? In difficult decisions do you ask yourself the question, “What would Jesus do?”

Jesus seeks to build his church on you. We must remember that Peter was far from perfect. Peter was afraid, lost his temper, doubted and denied Christ 3 times. But our Lord still sought to build his church on him because of his sincere love and desire to serve our Lord. We too are rocks that Jesus seeks to build on- our Lord seeks to build his church on you! We are called to be a man/woman of faith, in word and practice, and a source of attraction for others to Christ and his church

Jesus asks each of us today, “Who do you say that I am?” The irony is that in answering this, we find out less about Jesus and more about ourselves.
