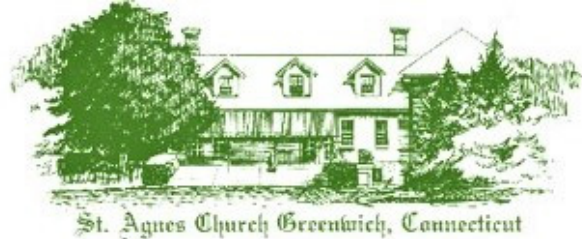

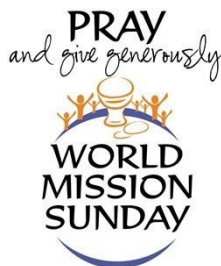

OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD

This is our 15th year contributing to this worthwhile project!



- Gift filled shoe boxes are distributed in over 100 countries to children in traumatic and impoverished areas
- If you would like to join in this project, please take a box from the back of the church.

Fill your box with age appropriate items. You choose the age range and whether your gift will be for a boy or girl, and then tape the label to the outside of the box. If you prefer, you can use a plastic shoe box container instead. You may gift wrap the boxes, but the lid must be wrapped separately. When these boxes are delivered, a small bible booklet will be given to each child in their own language.

There are certain items which should not be included such as toy guns, knives or military figures; chocolate or food; liquids or lotions; medications or vitamins; breakable items such as snow globes or glass containers; aerosol cans.

Please enclose a check in the amount of \$9.00 for each box to help cover shipping. Checks should be made payable to Samaritan's Purse. When these boxes are delivered, a small bible booklet will be given to each child in their own language.

Filled shoe boxes should be dropped off on the table at the entrance to the church not later than November 17. No boxes will be picked up or delivered after that date.

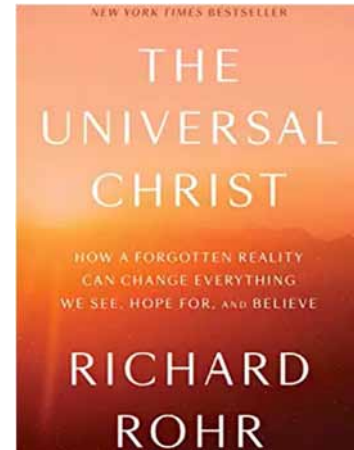

The Universal Christ: How a Forgotten Reality can Change Everything We See, Hope For and Believe, by Richard Rohr

Father Richard Rohr asks readers to broaden their ideas of “Christ” beyond the physical person of Jesus. As he states in one of the early chapters, “Christ” is not Jesus’ last name. Rohr’s central assertion seems to be that we recognize Christ in the Bible – and in the world – as both part of the person of Jesus but also as someone/something that pre-dates Jesus and is larger than the person of Jesus. This recognition then changes how we see not only issues of faith but also one another and all examples of creation.
