COLLECTION FOR THE ARCHDIOCESE FOR THE MILITARY SERVICES

Next weekend our parish will take up the Collection for the Archdiocese for the Military Services, USA (AMS). Established by Saint John Paul II in 1985, the AMS is the only U.S. diocese responsible for providing pastoral care to men and women serving in the U.S. Armed Forces, enrolled at a U.S. Military Academy, being treated as a patient at any of the 153 U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Centers, or working for the federal government beyond U.S. borders – including those from our own parish and diocese. Including families, AMS priests and deacons serve approximately 1.8 million Catholics who hail from 50 states and U.S. territories. While the salaries and retirement of Catholic military chaplains are paid for by the U.S. Government, the AMS does not receive any funding from the government or military for program and administrative costs. This is a reminder to fill your shoe boxes. If you need another box, please contact Betsy Parker at 203-637-8092. Or you may use a plastic shoe box. This is an extra benefit as it can be used to hold water for washing. If you do use a plastic box and want to wrap it, remember to wrap the lid separately from the bottom and don't seal them together. The boxes need to be opened for inspection. Hint: place the wrapping on the inside so that it won't tear in transit.

Tape the label stating whether it is for a boy or a girl and the age category on the outside of the box. On the inside include a check made out to Samaritan's Purse for the amount of \$9.00. This will cover the cost of shipping and handling.

*Please be aware that there are certain items which **MUST NOT** be included such as candy, gum, toothpaste, toy guns, knives, military figures, chocolate, food, seeds, fruit snacks, drink mixes, liquids, lotions, medications, vitamins, snow globes, glass containers, aerosol cans.*

The deadline for returning boxes is November 16 and 17. Please place the completed boxes on the table at the entrance of the church. Thank you for your generosity.

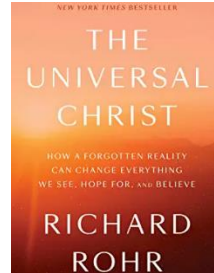

*The Universal Christ:
How a Forgotten Reality can
Change Everything We See,
Hope For and Believe,*
by Richard Rohr

Father Richard Rohr asks readers to broaden their ideas of "Christ" beyond the physical person of Jesus. As he states in one of the early chapters, "Christ" is not Jesus' last name. Rohr's central assertion seems to be that we recognize Christ in the Bible – and in the world – as both part of the person of Jesus but also as someone/something that pre-dates Jesus and is larger than the person of Jesus. This recognition then changes how we see not only issues of faith but also one another and all examples of creation.
