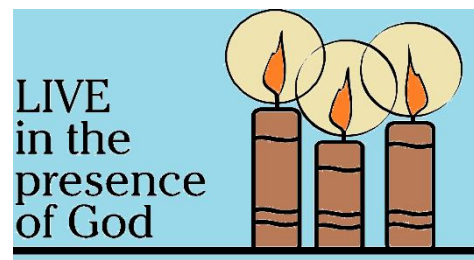


YOU CAN BE AN ALTAR SERVER!
