MORE ON FAITH FORMATION



A short series of thoughts on the impact of this historic, critically defining event of our Church not just for the 20th century, but for this new millennium as well Part 5

This series is about Vatican II, the worldwide Council of the Roman Catholic Church which met from 1962 through 1965 in Rome. It's about Vatican II's theology and successful reform of the Church. Last week's column ended by saying that many of the Council's decisions reached right down into the pews of our parish of St. Catherine of Siena and St. Agnes and into the lives of all of us who occupy these pews.

It was after all, in the pews of the Church that the reforms enacted by Vatican II were felt most strongly. In the earlier columns, we looked at how the Council tackled many controversial issues, but it's real impact, the place where it touched us most was in the place where we could see the changes: where we pray in the celebration of the Eucharist. Most of us have our primary contact with the Church through the celebration of the sacraments, first and foremost of which is what we have commonly called "the Mass." We think of ourselves as "practicing or active Catholics" if we

attend Mass regularly. With the promulgation of the document on Sacred Liturgy, *Sacrosanctum Concilium*, in December of 1963, the Council clearly stated that it had a duty to provide for the renewal and fostering of the liturgy. For it is through the liturgy, especially the celebration of the Eucharist that the work of our redemption is exercised. So, perhaps it is appropriate in this column to look at a few passages from the document on the Liturgy which have had profound implications for us, the persons "in the pews."

In the very first chapter of the document, it presents to us a sharp elucidation on the doctrine of the "real presence" of Christ in the Eucharist, and it requires of us "in the pews" to expand our notion of that concept beyond seeing Christ present only in the consecrated bread and wine. The document enunciates four(4) ways in which Christ is really and truly present in the celebration of the Eucharist:

"Christ is always present in his Church, especially in her liturgical celebrations. He is present in the person of His ordained priest (1), and in the Eucharistic species of the bread and wine(2). He is present in His Word when the Scriptures are read (3). And finally, He is present when the gathered assembly prays and sings, for He promised that where two or three are gathered in His name, there He is in their midst(4)."

So, here is the Church's teaching on the "real presence" of Christ in the Eucharist. Do we embrace this teaching fully?

Let's end this column with what is, no doubt, the most widely expressed quote from the document on the Liturgy. "Mother Church earnestly desires that all the faithful be led to that full, conscious and active participation in the liturgical celebrations that is their right and duty by reason of their baptism." We'll explore this idea more fully next week in our last column in this series.
