A Reflection

What I dread the most about being sick is the uncertainty of it all. I find myself, sooner or later, coming up against the most disconcerting of feelings: there's no assurance that I'll ever be able to return to the life I knew and that, until now, I had taken for granted. Then, gradually, I find myself climbing out of that gloomy place and am cheered to see a faint ray of light even if it's still rather distant. That little ray is, of course, hope; it's those I come across that make time to stay reassuringly at my side. It's their presence above all that makes the difference.

This quarantining business is difficult: it either isolates us or nudges us into being uncomfortably close to each other. Sometimes it turns out to be both feelings rolled into one. We humans are complex animals; we need both the freedom of space and the company of others! We're not made for this... and yet! Human life is not a straight line – unexpected things happen to us that make us appreciate and take note of our surroundings. We become aware of changes we need to bring about so as to grow, survive, take better care of this little planet of ours, and of our fellow sentient beings without whose company and love we cannot realize our human potential. It's a time perhaps to reflect and give that distant glimmer a chance.
