

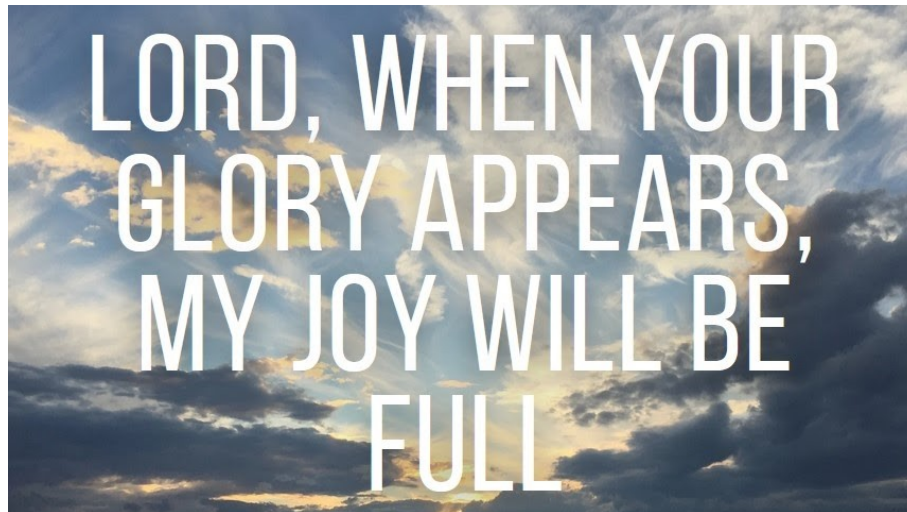

OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD A PROJECT OF SAMARITAN'S PURSE

This is a reminder to fill your shoe boxes. If you need another box, please **contact Betsy Parker** at 203-637-8092 or **Janet Wrabel** at janet.wrabel@stc-sta.org. Or you may use a plastic shoe box—this is an extra benefit as it can be used to hold water for washing. If you do use a plastic box and want to wrap it, remember to wrap the lid separately from the bottom and don't seal them together. The boxes need to be opened for inspection.

Hint: place the wrapping on the inside so that it won't tear in transit.

Tape the label stating whether it is for a boy or a girl and the age category on the outside of the box. On the inside, **include a check** made out to **Samaritan's Purse** for the amount of **\$10.00**. This will cover the cost of shipping and handling.

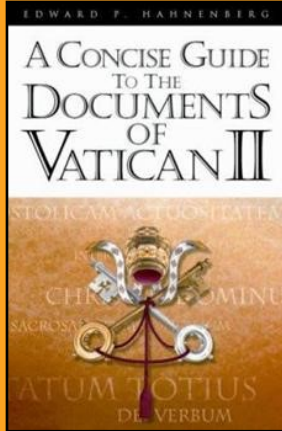

Vatican II Review: November 9 through January 11

In light of the 60th anniversary of Vatican II, Barbara Glynn and Barbara Linton are planning a review of the documents of Vatican II and invite your participation in the study. We will use *A Concise Guide to the Documents of Vatican II*, by Edward Hahnenberg. Please order your own copy (approx. \$20; 150 pages) ASAP.

We will begin on Wednesday, November 9 in the Lucey Parish Hall at **9:45 AM until approximately 11:30 AM**. The course will end on January 11.

October 16, on the 60th Anniversary of the opening of the Second Vatican Council, it's good to remember what the Council accomplished. And the best summation comes from the late John W. O'Malley, SJ, the Dean of Church Historians, in his magisterial book, "What Happened at Vatican II." At the end, he sums up the legacy of Vatican II. In short, the church moved from "commands to invitations, from laws to ideals, from definition to mystery, from threats to persuasion, from coercion to conscience, from monologue to dialogue, from ruling to serving, from withdrawn to integrated, from vertical to horizontal, from exclusion to inclusion, from hostility to friendship, from rivalry to partnership, from suspicion to trust, from static to ongoing, from passive acceptances to active engagement, from fault-finding to appreciation, from prescriptive to principles, from behavior modification to inner appropriation."

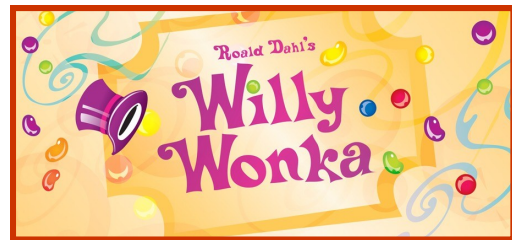
